The African REN Ecosystem – UA (1)

- UbuntuNet Alliance incorporated in 2005
- Regional REN for Eastern and Southern Africa
- 15 Members
 - Eba@le DRC; BERNET Burundi; EthERNet Ethiopia
 - KENET Kenya; iRENALA Magascar; MAREN Malawi
 - MoRENet Mozambique; Xnet Namibia; RwEdNet Rwanda
 - SomaliREN Somalia; TENET South Africa; SudREN Sudan
 - TERNET Tanzania; RENU Uganda; ZAMREN Zambia
- Operational Network
- Connected to the global R&E network via links to GEANT
- Successfully winded up first phase of AfricaConnect (EC funding) and preparing second phase




The African REN Ecosystem – ASREN (1)

- Incorporated in 2010 as a not for profit organisation
- Currently 9 formally established NRENs
 - GARNET Ghana
 - snRER Senegal
 - MaliREN Mali
 - Niger-REN Niger
 - GabonREN Gabon
 - NgREN Nigeria
 - TogoRER Togo
 - RerBenin Benin
 - Cameroon RIC
- Associate members: RENATER (FR), Eko-Konnect (NG)
- Initiatives in Burkina Faso, Chad, Guinea and Cape Verde



WACREN in a nutshell (cont'd)






Proposed network topology

- Core + Access
 - 10G+ Core
 - 1G+ Access
- 3 main hubs: Accra; Dakar and Lagos (+ Douala/ Libreville)
- Redundant links from hubs to NRENs
- At least 2 intl. links: to Paris and London
- Multiple Submarine Cable Access
- Medium term leases



Proposed network topology (cont'd)



Advocacy



- AfricaConnect2 (EC-funded) high on WACREN's agenda
- Several authorities approached for sensitization
 - ECOWAS
 - UEMOA
 - AfDB
 - WATRA (regional association of telecom regulators)
 - Governments
 - Côte d'Ivoire
 - Sénégal
 - Nigeria
 - Niger
 - Togo
- Other issues being addressed with the authorities
 - Legal status of the NRENs
 - Full-time staffing

Federation Basics



- Identity Provider (IdP) entities (e.g. academic and research institutions, enterprises, etc.) authenticating their users and certifying their identities
- Service Provider (SP) entities providing services to the federation. They receive individual users' personal data, under consent and provide personalized services
- Federation Circle of Trust including one or more IdPs and SPs enabling Single Sign On (SSO)

WACREN EduID Objectives



- Bootstrap establishment of NREN federations
- Resolve implementation issues
 - Lack of server infrastructure and issues with electricity
 - Lack of understanding of the technology and knowledge to deploy and maintain
 - Lack of familiarity with identity management systems and managing user databases
 - Limited funding and resources to operate

WACREN EduID Approach



- Policy and Practice
 - Federation policy development workshops
 - Localised templates for federation policy and practice statements
- Technology Support
 - Federation as a Service (FaaS)
 - Register Identity Provider
 - Identity Provider in the Cloud
 - Training on use of WACREN EduiD


Metadata Resource Registry



- Centrally hosted Metadata Management
 - Based on software from HEAnet, the Irish NREN
 - WACREN modifying the code to create role for NREN federation administrators
 - Resultant effect = 100% control by NRENs of their federation metadata and entities
- Federation administrators register Identity Providers (IdP) and Service Providers(SP) in their respective federations

H2020 Projects

- WACREN is Consortium Member in three (3) projects funded in the framework of European Commission Horizon 2020 Programme
- Projects from May 2015 April 2017
- TANDEM (TransAfrican Network Development)
 - Aimed at creating the favourable conditions for WACREN to benefit maximally from AfricaConnect2
 - ensure WACREN integration into the global Research and Education networking community and long-term sustainability
- Ongoing NREN needs survey

H2020 Projects (cont'd)

- Sci-GaIA (Energising Scientific Endeavour through Science Gateways and e-Infrastructures in Africa)
 - Aimed at producing clearly structured guides and educational documents for training NREN representatives, Communities of Practice (CoPs), and, importantly, to get universities to develop Science Gateways and e-Infrastructures in Africa
 - Participation requires federated access

- MAGIC (Middleware for collaborative Apps and Global vIrtual Communities)
 - Aims at establishing a set of agreements for participating world regions – Africa
 - Consolidate middleware for a marketplace of services and real-time applications to benefit global science communities

AfricaConnect 2

- Second phase of the AfricaConnect Project
- EC Funding (26.6 M€)
- Project duration: 2015 2018
- Objective: Support RENs in Africa and interconnect with GEANT
- Three clusters
 - Cluster 1: UbuntuNet Alliance
 - Cluster 2: WACREN
 - Cluster 3: ASREN
- 80:20% funding scheme
- Budget for Cluster 2: 12.25 M€ (2.5 M€ counter-funding by WACREN)
- Implementation of Cluster 2 component: GEANT and WACREN
