Our work to date

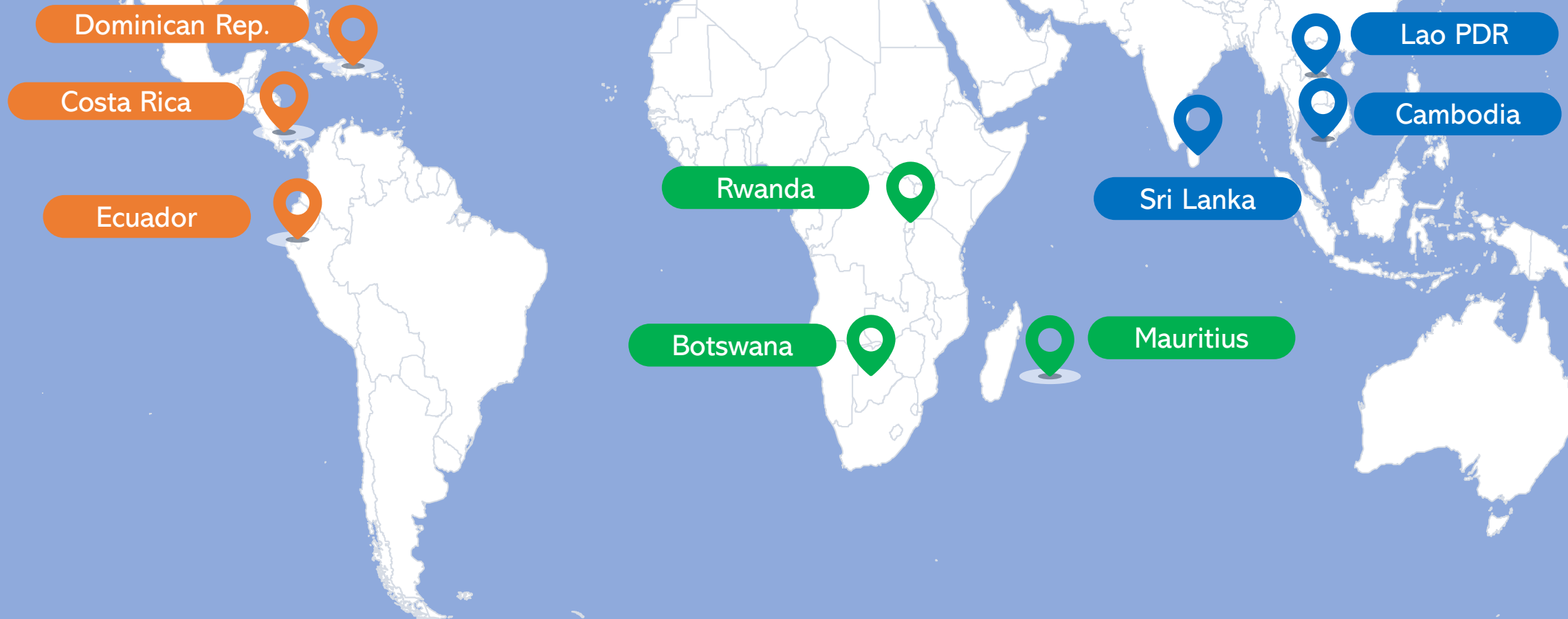


Since our commencement in 2018, the project has built strong relationships with partners across the globe
