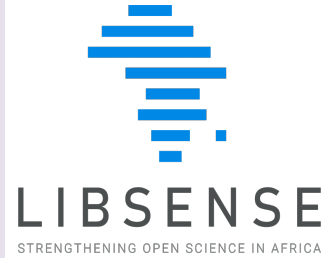




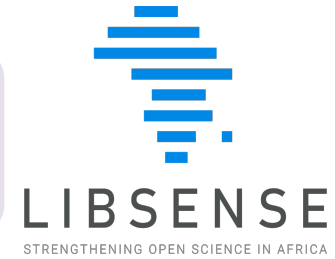

African researchers wishing to publish public health research in local journals have varying opportunities

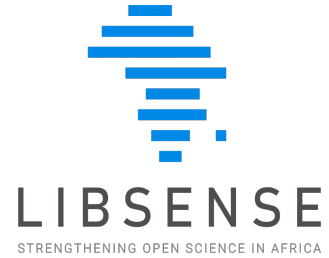
Many face Article Processing Charges

More research?

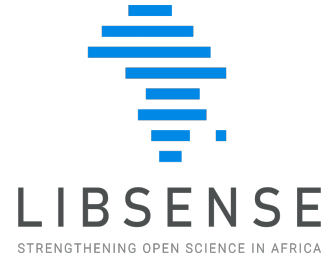
Education/support programme?
