➤ **Current Challenges:**

Underrepresentation of women in climate science, **particularly in data analysis roles**, due to limited access to resources, training, and mentorship.

➤ **Opportunities for GARNET:**

By leveraging its capabilities, GARNET can play a crucial role in empowering women to take on more significant roles in climate data analysis.

The Organisation is owned by its members.





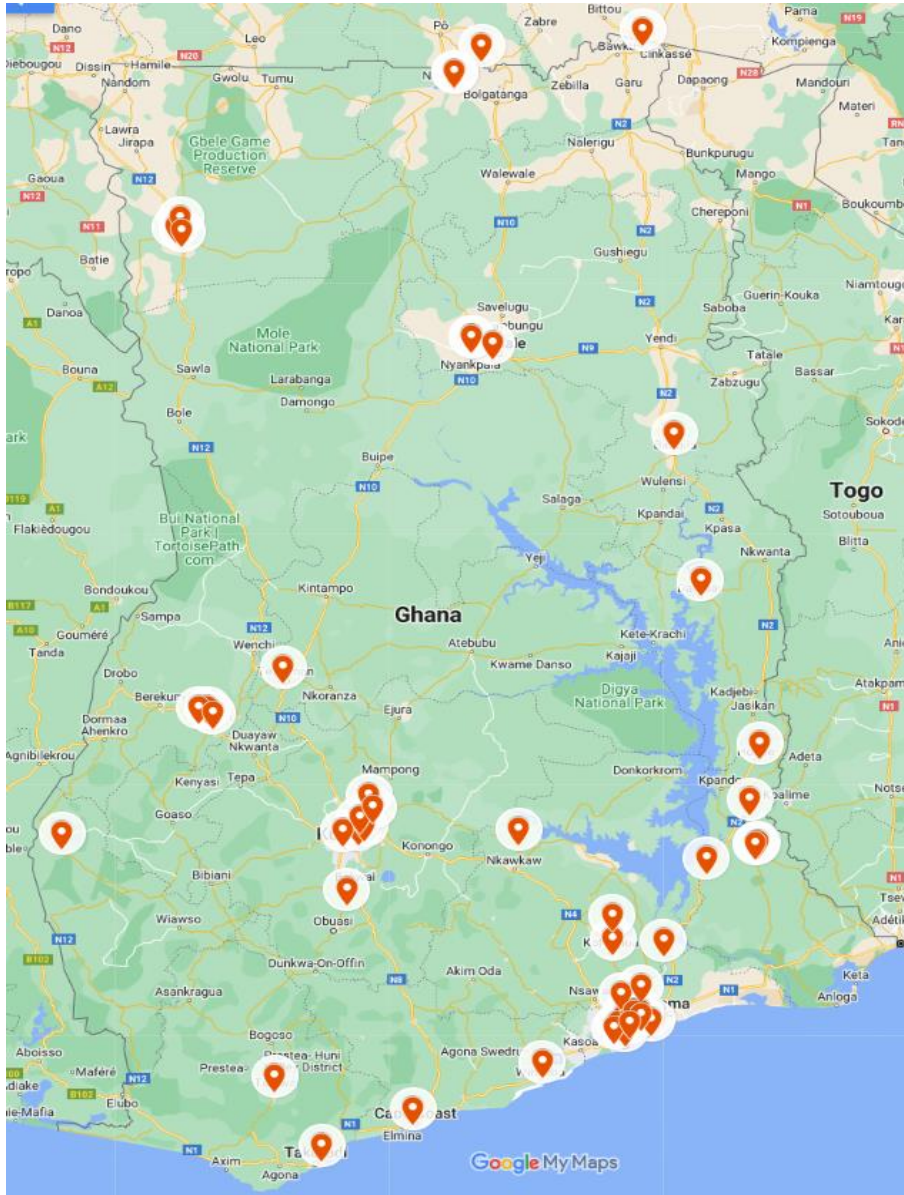
- Provide or facilitate **technical support services** to member institutions.

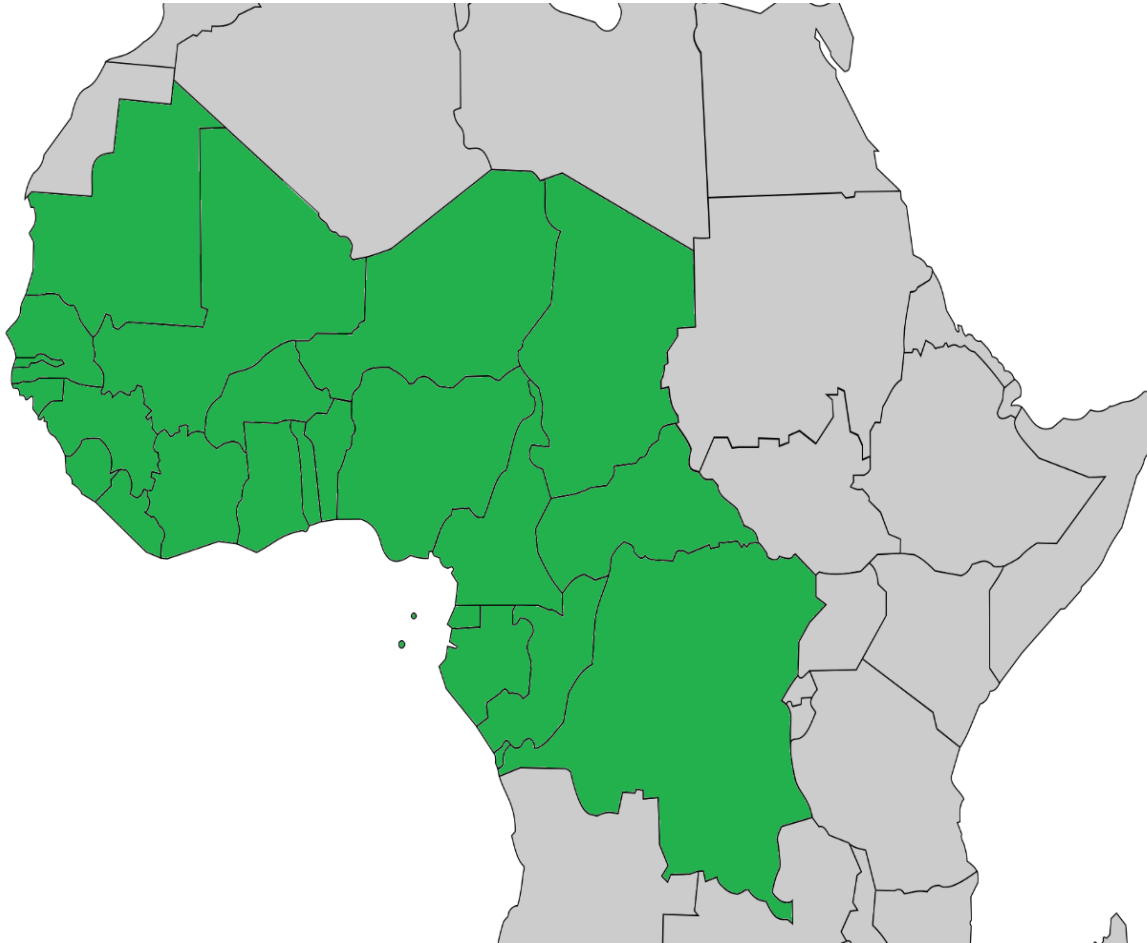

- Specialized Services: Provides **platforms for e-learning, cloud services, and data storage** crucial for climate data analysis.

- **Overall population impacted is in excess of 550,000**
 - 525,000 students
 - 55/45 percentage Male to female split

- **Improved access** to internet for students, faculty and researchers
 - Access to Wi-fi in student hostels, computer labs, and Libraries
 - Access to research and educational content and HPC Services
 - Science Gateway and limited number of Sensors deployed

Leverage GARNET's Capabilities to Empower Women

➤ Access to Resources and Training:

- Provide women with **access** to the necessary **tools, data sets, and high-speed internet** needed for climate data analysis.
- Organize **targeted workshops and training sessions focused on data analysis skills**, utilizing GARNET's network and partnerships.

➤ Mentorship and Networking Opportunities:

- Use **GARNET's connectivity to foster online communities for women** in climate science, enabling knowledge sharing and collaboration.



Leverage GARNET's Capabilities to Empower Women... Continued

➤ Promoting Research and Collaboration:

- Encourage interdisciplinary research projects that involve women researchers, leveraging GARNET's links with international research networks.



Building a Climate Data Hub:

- Develop a dedicated climate data hub within GARNET to facilitate access to global and regional climate data sets, tailored to support female researchers.

Collaborate with GMeT and WACREN

Expansion of Training Programs:

- Collaborate with international organizations to expand training programs specifically designed for women in climate science and data analysis.

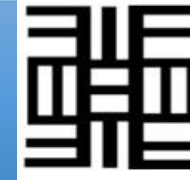
Establishing a Women in Climate Science Fellowship:

- Introduce a fellowship program to support women pursuing careers in climate data analysis, offering funding, resources, and mentorship.

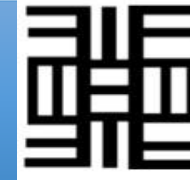


Developing Partnerships for Sustainability:

- **Strengthen partnerships** with governmental, non-governmental, and international organizations to **secure funding and resources** to sustain and scale up **initiatives aimed at boosting women's impact in climate data analysis.**



- Facilitate Transport of **Earth Observation data**, from satellites and sensors to Meteorological and Geological Survey agencies **using highspeed terrestrial links**.
- Negotiate Community Price Deal for Anti-plagiarism software Service – **Turnitin and Network devices**



- Deploy eLearning Management Systems Platform (LMS).
- Deploy **open access repository and publishing platform** (in Collaboration with CARLIGH and LIBSENSE)
- Implement a **Ghana Qualifications Register** - Digital Certificates.
- Deploy **Datawarehouse and Analytics** Portal (Education & earth observation).
- **Establish the GARNET Identity Federation and facilitate single sign-on** to access academic and research services.
