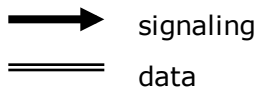
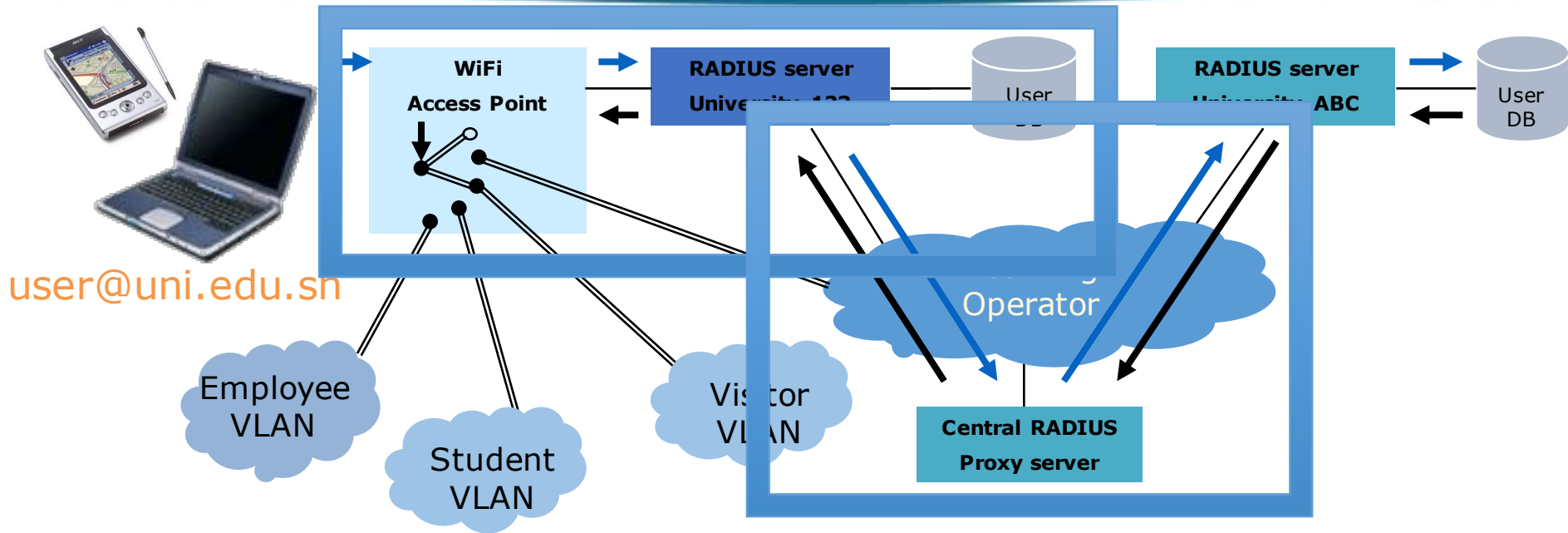


education roaming

# The Situation on Campus: Lots of Applications



- More applications for students and researchers
- Applications require authentication and authorization

## Solution #1: LDAP

- Centralised Password & Account Storage
- Re-use of Accounts/Password across applications
- Focus password security at one location
- One account for all applications

## Solution #2: Web Single Sign-On (SSO)

- Centralised Account Login
- Re-use of Accounts across applications without another login (while your session is valid)
- No Man-in-the-Middle password attack from LDAP connected applications
- Still limited to the campus...



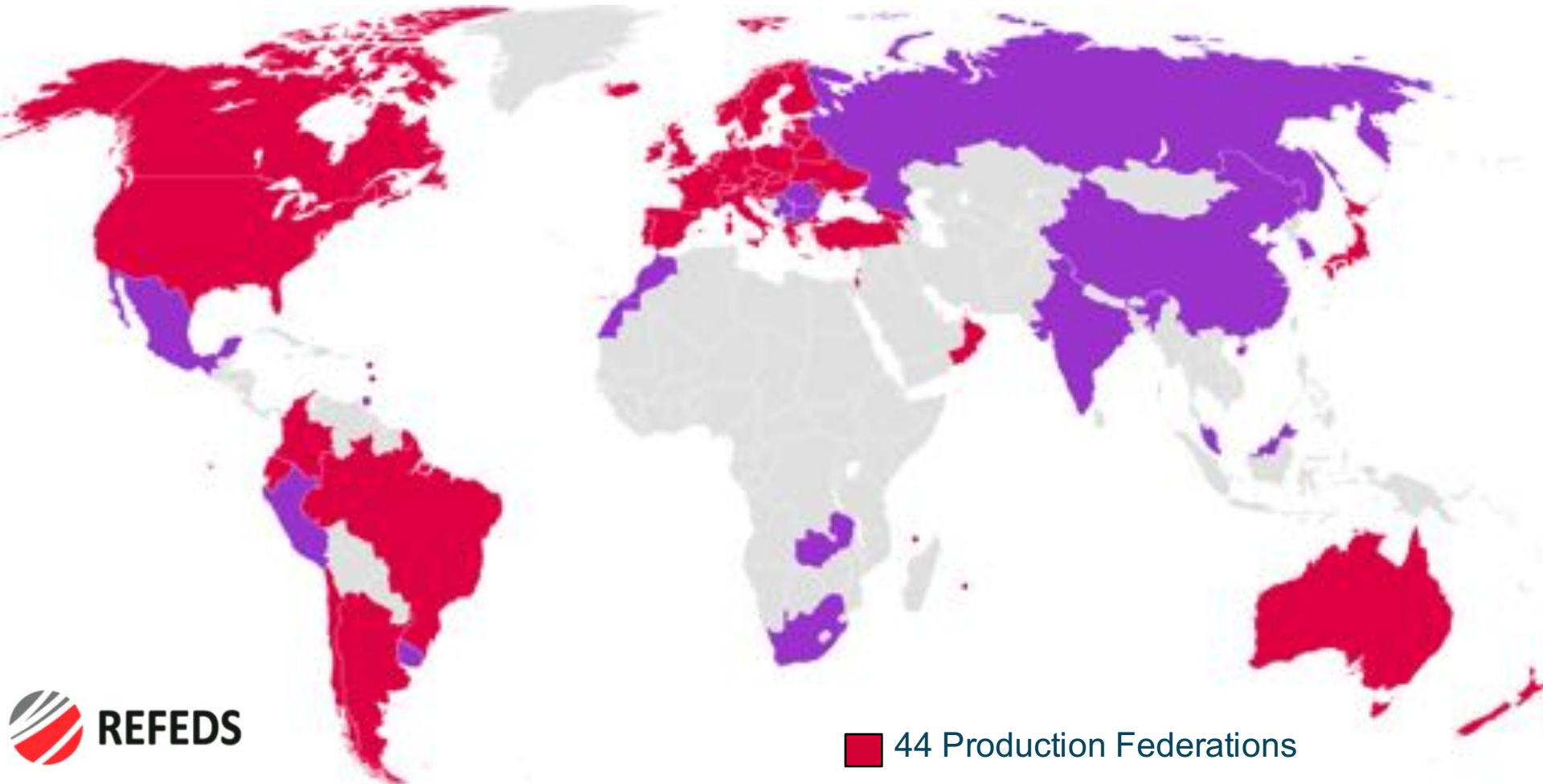

■ 17 Pilot Federations

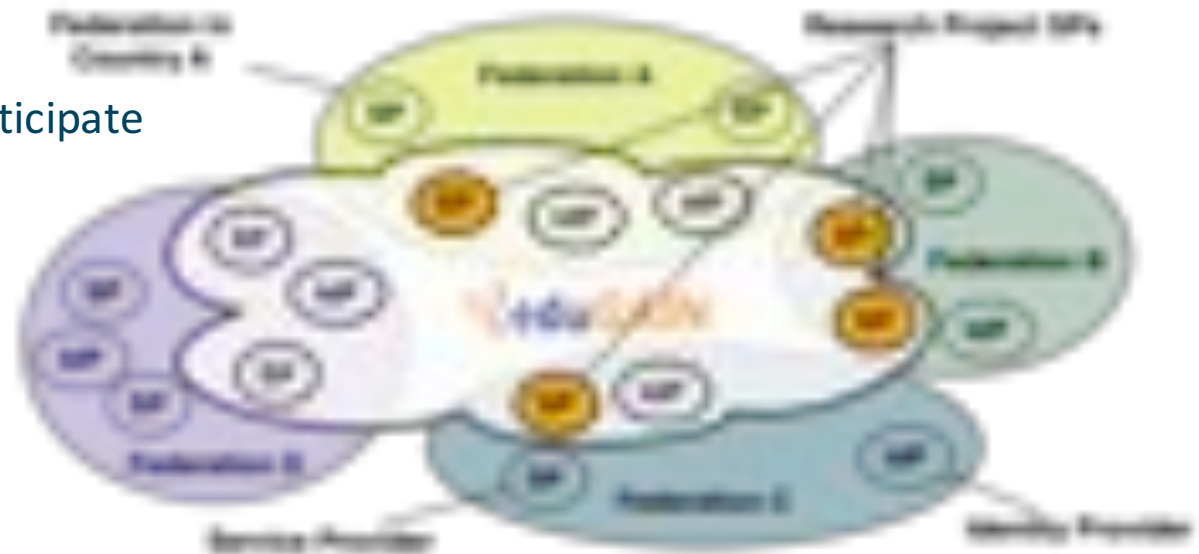

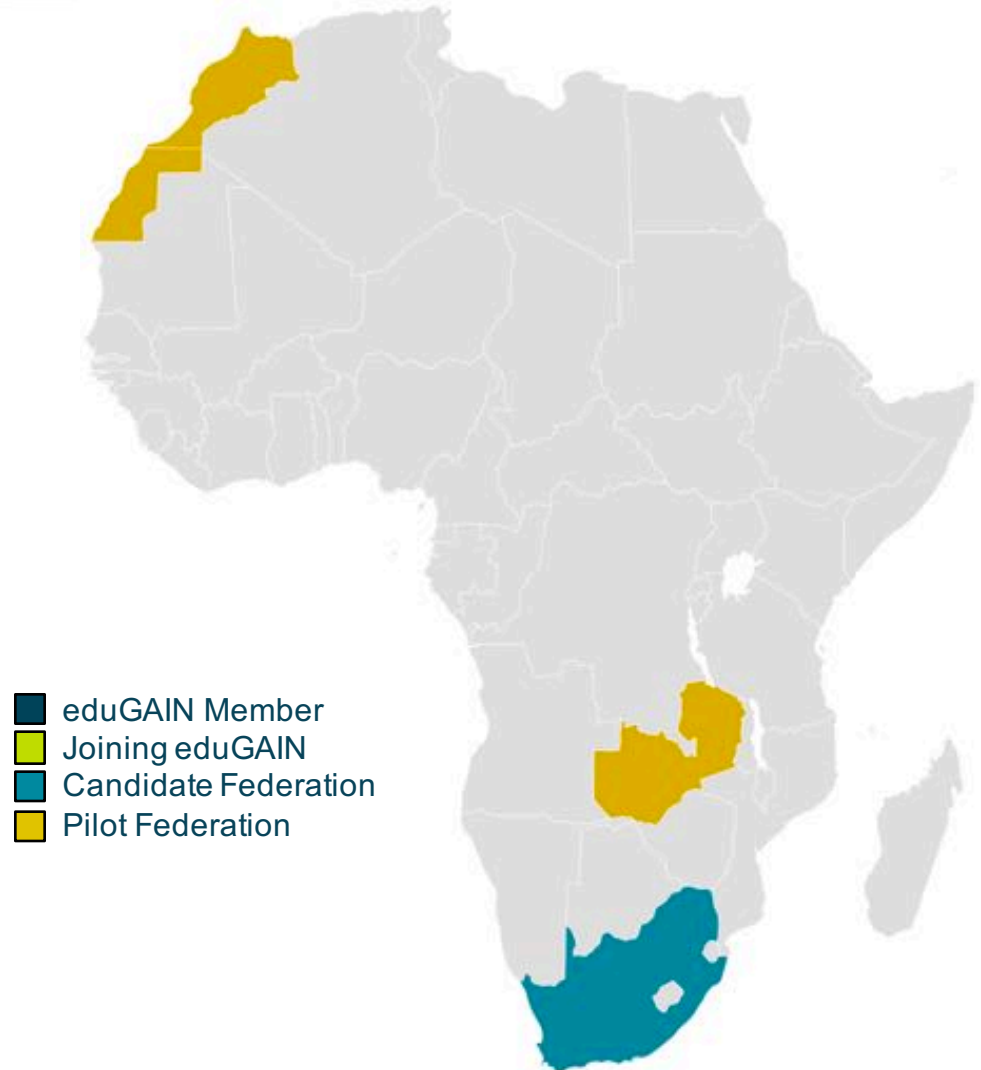
