## Best Practices for Peer Review Conducting Effective Peer Reviews

- Focus on constructive feedback, not just criticism
- Address structure, clarity, coherence, and originality
- Be respectful and objective—separate the content from the creator
- Use inline comments in Ketty's Wax editor for clarity
- Stick to agreed timelines for feedback
- Avoid rewriting—suggest improvements, don't impose style





#### **Print Book Publishing - Constraints**



These factors, among others, are leading publishers to explore digital book publishing options for easy access and wider reach.



## Editor-Author Communication in BookHub: Building Healthy Editorial Relationships

- Maintain open, respectful tone in comments
- Clarify suggestions using examples
- Use in-line comment threads to discuss specific sections
- Schedule live check-ins or chat discussions after review
- Track and resolve comment threads within Ketty to maintain progress



# Managing Revisions and Editorial Standards: Managing Revisions Effectively

- Authors should address comments before editing content
- Editors track revision progress via version history in Ketty
- Agree on an editorial checklist (grammar, tone, formatting, citations)
- Encourage authors to self-review changes before final submission
- Final review ensures editorial consistency and readiness for export


