# Improving Research

- Research not confined to location.
- Requires collaboration among researchers in disparate locations.
- Requires access to resources.
- Access to raw research data is required to validate research undertaken and findings deduced.
- Availability of raw data extends research.
- How do NRENs Help?

# What is a Research Community?

- Group of Scientists working together using common e-infrastructure.
- An NRENs goal is to provide a platform for its community (includes researchers) that utilises infrastructure and services to improve collaboration.
- Researchers should be aware of resources available to them from their NRENs to improve research and promote greater visibility.
- NRENs offer more than just providing bandwidth

# The NgREN Federation

- A set of trust domains participating in a confederation that shares some common attributes.
- Federations allows NREN members to have secure & controlled access to resources and services.
- Comprised of Identity Providers (academic and research institutions).
- Service Providers: Entities that provide services by receiving information about a user from a trusted domain and providing services based on defined policies.
- Developing NgREN federation is important for institutions to gain access to available services.

# Catch-all Federation

- Developing a national federation requires development of IdPs, SPs and confederation
- Institution IdP's need to be deployed and policies defined which takes some time.
- Catch-all IdPs are a way for users or institutions that have not yet part of a federation or not have not created their IdPs to gain federated access to some services.

# What Researchers Can Contribute

- EU Projects promoting e-infrastructure have built demonstration platforms to showcase applications that can be used by African scientists.
- Make research projects available via federated access through the creation of science gateways (SGW).
- African Centres of Excellence and projects involved with the collection and analysis of large data sets are suited for such e-infrastructure & SGW development.
- Sci-GaIA winter school aims to build technical capacity
- Eko-Konnect willing to collaborate with researchers and their institutions in SGW and e-infrastructure development.
- Complement Sci-GaIA capacity building activities.

# DevOps & Ansible Training

- Concluded Workshop a starting point for Researchers, their Technical teams and Eko-Konnect to develop IdP and see how research projects can leverage
- The WACREN EduID Cloud Solution will help fast track IdP development for Institutions with infrastructure challenges.
- Participation in Sci-GalA projects facilitated by WACREN (Eko-Konnect is WACREN affiliate member) will create awareness and exposure to additional support beyond NREN support.

- Fast track Federation development
- Leveraging WACREN EduID Cloud Infrastructure
- GBB Partnering with WACREN to provide hosting services.
- Eko-Konnect providing pilot institutions on the back of DevOps Workshop and this seminar.
- Precursor to deployment of other services that can be leveraged and offered by researchers e.g. Science Gateways.

- Opportunity to improve research output by providing e-infrastructure for research that involves large data sets.
