Introduction

- USIU-Africa has over 70 e-databases, with 25 being subscription databases; Over 100,000 online journals; 264,378 e-books; and a huge print collection
- With the vast amounts of information resources, the library search environment becomes increasingly fragmented and therefore overwhelming and frustrating for users
- Users want a Google-like simple search functionality with access to all Library's collection from a single, easy-to-use search interface – Discovery platform!



Discovery platform defined

"A web-scale discovery service is a large central index paired with a richly featured user interface providing a single point of access to the library's local, open access, and subscription collections.


Web-scale discovery services offer a variety of modern search tool features and functionality including: autocorrect, relevance ranking, faceted browsing which make it easier for users to locate library materials more efficiently and enhanced content such as cover images, ratings, and reviews offering an enriched user experience while providing useful contextual information for evaluating results."

USIU-Africa EBSCO-Enterprise Discovery platform (USIULibFind)



What's in place

Informed by research on features of an optimized web-scale discovery system


- Search suggestion functionality: list of suggestions in the search from search history terms within Enterprise
- Correction of input errors: via a "Did you mean ...?" function.
- Interfiling results: Integrated Library System (ILS) and EDS display results on the same screen
- Limiter: Limiter by full text available
- Filter function: Wide choice of Facets for various search refinement e.g. subject, format, publisher
- Search results display: relevance ranking and availability: The "best" hit is displayed first, not necessarily the newest one
- Search display widget: 'text & image alignment' and 'item format label'


What's in place cont...

- Password request: Off when on-campus or using VPN
- Exploratory search: Finds results of interest not specifically requested, related words, and equivalent subjects
- Publication titles: publication titles and publishers are listed for e-journal results
- Placard journal e.g. journal of business
- Languages: supports five languages for title labels
- Content providers indexing: List of an aggregation of different providers
- Publication finder: available on EBSCO platform
- Digital Repository harvesting









Usage Statistics & Impact

- Statistics on discoverability and access of the library resources have extremely increased with over 100% increase registered during the implementation period even prior to the official launch
- Information Literacy trainers note:

"Taking users through the different databases and sources of information was not only cumbersome but time consuming. USIULibFind is a time saver!"



Project details

- Project kicked off in February 2018
- Several WebEx meetings and email conversations with EBSCO & SirsiDynix teams
- Sharing lists of subscribed as well as open access resources
- Project completion check list: EDS rubric by Joseph Deodato (2015) and EBSCO QA checklist
- Project closure: continuous free consultation with global support team available 24 hrs, part of the subscription package



Challenges

- ✓ Auto-complete search: Has "Search suggestion" functionality only which suggests terms that have been looked up at least 3 times in the last 10 days. Auto-complete is available on *EBSCO platform*
- ✓ Fixed Number of results per page at 12 has been recorded as an enhancement request
- ✓ Need to randomly confirm added titles (especially subscribed e-resources and ebooks) are discoverable
- ✓ Vendors agreement with Publishers matters! There could be restrictions on content that can be added
- ✓ Need for regular update of lists / indexing need for dedicated team
- ✓ Content bias? (ranking!)



Best practices & Conclusion

- Be sure to use a vendor putting in consideration:
 - ✓ Potential features of the discovery platform &
 - ✓ Publisher partnerships / legal issues

EBSCO Discovery Service, ProQuest's Summon, Ex Libris' Primo, OCLC's WorldCat

- Put in place a dedicated team Library & ICT
- Consider budget availability annual subscription
